




**Canale di Tenno** is a medieval borgo and an obligatory stop for those who desire to immerse themselves in the magic of a place of the past, where you breathe history, art and culture. Entrenched on a mountain slope halfway Lake Garda and the Alps, has recently been included in the list of the most beautiful villages in Italy and this is not surprising: narrow paved alleys, arcades, small internal squares, houses set one against the other like in the ancient villages of the 13th century.

The borgo of Tellaro is a real gem on the Gulf of Poets. Its etruscan origins and its typical houses hurled together are spilling down the hillside toward the tiny, secluded harbour. 














#### SONCINO – Lombardia

An enchanted medieval village, one of those small jewels of Italy of a unique and original beauty that deserves to be seen. His Sforza Castle was a very famous movie set, who does not know Lady Hawke? Its historic center has a decidedly medieval character, surrounded by a well-preserved city wall and characterized by very narrow streets, stately homes and tower-houses.











#### **ZAVATTARELLO – Lombardia**

A small Medieval borgo in Oltrepò Pavese, in the high valley of the Tidone river. In a strategic position since ancient times, this town is situated in that part of Northern Italy called "Four Regions", because it's the meeting point of four different regions: Lombardy, Piedmont, Emilia Romagna and Liguria. In the heart of Zavattarello, dominated by the Dal Verme Castle, the stone houses preserve their ancient athmosphere: this is the Medieval village, which the inhabitants call the Inner Village because it was surrounded by strong fortification walls.

#### **MONTEGRIDOLFO – Emilia Romagna**

Located on the border between Emilia Romagna and Marche, Montegridolfo is one of the best preserved borgo in Italy. Over the centuries it has been venue of frequent military battles and for this reason was designed and built as a rectangular fortress, with a tower overlooking the walls. The elegant structures and the historic buildings of the Borgo have been restored with painstaking care so that you can breathe the ancient charm atmosphere everywhere in this town while walking along the silent streets or visiting its churches and palaces.

### SAN LEO – Emilia Romagna

Located on a spur of rock of the Marecchia valley from where you can observe San Marino and the Marecchia, on the border between Romagna and the Marche, San Leo has long been the historical capital of the "region" of Montefeltro. It was a place of passage of Saint Francis, 1213, and Dante 1306, prison of Felice Orsini and Cagliostro.



### SCARPERIA – Toscana

Historically united by the presence of the Medici family, who left many traces of their glorious past in the two cities, they have become a single entity in 2014. This ancient borgo grew around the church by the same name in roughly the 11th century, but in the 14th and 15th centuries it lived its most important moment in history. The Medici family built many buildings in the area as Castello del Trebbio (marvelous medieval structure built on a feudal tower and classoified, in 2013 UNESCO world heritage site) and also historic buildings within the city as Villa Adami (which today houses the library) and Villa Schifanoia.

### ALTA MAREMMA – Toscana

Maremma is the southernmost area of Tuscany and identifies a lifestyle based on respect for the environment, for the culture and for the preservation of traditions. Visit the Maremma is a magnificent journey through colors, perfumes, history, sea and lakes. Spread on its territory rise beautiful and ancient medieval *borghi* of incomparable beauty.

**Santa Fiora** has the fascination of a small mountain borgo particularly rich in history and traditions that have remained until today as testimony to a grand past as ancient capital of this side of the mountain.



**Sovana** is a very picturesque borgo of Etruscan origin and developed in the seventh century BC: certainly among the loveliest in southern Tuscany, with an attractive medieval centre and several ancient and historical monuments of interest to discover.



**Porrona** is one of the finest examples of medieval Tuscan borgo built around 1100: it quickly became the place to stay for the Sienese noble families that shared control over the castle and the nearby palace located in the central part of the borgo itself.











## SAN CASCIANO DEI BAGNI – Toscana

On the southern slopes of Mount Cetona, perched on the top of a hill, stands the ancient village of San Casciano dei Bagni. Thermal water, clayey soil and uncontaminated vegetation has given fame to this territory since pre-history, favored by its central position and flanked by the road arteries of the Roman consular Via Cassia and the Via Francigena. The territory reached the peak of its prosperity in the XVII-XVIII centuries; today the village has rediscovered its ancient thermal vocation and can boast of one of the most prestigious spas in the world, all in a setting of uncontaminated territory and an untouched landscape.















## **DERUTA – Umbria**

An ancient borgo lying on the banks of the Tiber River, its origins date back to Roman times but it is in the Middle Ages which had a very important role, as demonstrated by its old town and its fortifications. In addition to its architectural charm it has been known since 1290 to be the land of origin of one of the most famous handicraft production in central Italy: Deruta ceramic. one of the points of historical and artistic interest and definitely the most significant of Deruta is the Ceramic Museum, located inside the fourteenth century former convent of Saint Francesco. Inside the museum are preserved individual pieces of ceramics and majolica from Deruta made over the years by master craftsmen.

# **GRADARA – Marche**

Not many people know that Gradara is a real borgo, rich in history, art and traditions. Lots of tourists come to visit the fortress, but then find themselves catapulted into a breathtaking scenery! It is known as the city of one of the most famous and tragic love stories in the world, the one between Paolo and Francesca, the two lovers of the Fifth Canto of Dante's Inferno. The fortress with its fortified village is one of the best preserved structures in Italy protected by two walls, the outer one with a length of 800 metres. The walls are reinforced at regular distances by fourteen square towers whose interior is open at the side of the village.














#### **TORRE ALFINA – Lazio**

Torre Alfina is located in a strip of land between Lazio, Umbria and Tuscany and it is considered one of the most beautiful hamlet in Italy. At 602 meters above sea level, it offers a 360 degrees the plateau on which it stands. The history of the borgo is one with that of the castle that was born in the Middle Ages around an existing observation tower. The castle, powerful and imperious, strong in its majestic crenellated towers covered in dark stone, is unquestionably one of the most beautiful and fascinating historic houses on the Umbria-Tuscany-Lazio territory.














#### ROME – Lazio
















#### **BOVINO – Puglia**




